What is a Low Organized Game?

- It has few rules
- It is low skill (you shouldn't have to practice to play)
- It is easy to implement (i.e. minimum rules, minimum equipment requirements, be adaptable to any space)
- It is safe, low risk
- It should emphasize Maximum Participation
- It should be FUN!

What do you have to do?

Your group's assignment is to create a low organized game that can be taught to your peers. You will have 15-20 minutes to present your activity, including instructions, activity time, and receive feedback from the class. You will also prepare and hand in a Plan of your game (See Handout 1).

Things to consider:

- What makes it challenging?
